

Microsoft 365 Phishing IP Address Whitelisting PowerShell Script:

If you are using Microsoft 365, you can now execute a PowerShell script to whitelist these IP addresses. You must have an administrator account on your client's system. Simply replace the UserPrincipalName: user@example.com with your admin email and the script will load all our IP addresses.
